Read with your child each night	Practise counting in multiples of either 2, 3, 4, 5 or 10  Write down number patterns	Combine your nature walk for science with a stroll through the woods.	Collect as many different types of materials from around your home and stick small bits into your book-with labels.	Create portraits of family members in pencil, watercolour, paint, pastel or charcoal
Practise spelling the high frequency words for Year 1 and Year 2 (You can search for these online)	Find and name 3d shapes in the environment; cone, cylinder, cube, cuboid, sphere, pyramid and prism	How many times can you skip in a minute? Complete this over the weeks to improve your stamina.	Think about wasting electricity- draw/write ways in which we can save power! Do you know where electricity comes from?	Make a moving toy- explore different methods of joining materials to make a toy.
Practise handwriting. Can your child form their letters correctly? Can they continue to form them correctly in words?	Tell the time - look at the clock at different times and see if you can read it. What are you doing at these times?	Stretch up high, and then touch your toes as many times in one minute.	Check your recycling box- what do you recycle each week from home? Can you do more?	Make a boat and see if it floats- think about the materials you might use to do it.
Investigate this set of homophones: Their There They're Use each of these correctly in a sentence.	Can you divide things into halves? Or thirds? Or quarters? Look at fractions around the home eg cut half of a cake or pizza.	Walk to school every Wednesday for the whole term.	Look at water- in liquid and ice form- How do you freeze water? What happens if you leave it outside? Is this the same for all liquids?	Create a model of the Titanic or sketch pictures of boats
Choose 5 words you find difficult to spell. Use a dictionary, and look up each word. Write the definition (meaning) of the word in your book.	Add and subtract two digit numbers using tens and ones or a number line (your child can show you how to do this)	Balance on one leg for one minute then try the other leg!	Research an animal that is extinct (or nearly). Find out why this happened.	Listen to pieces of music linked to water. How do they make you feel? Try to recreate it and record it for us.
