ALTERATIONS TO Y1 & Y2 START & END OF THE DAY



As the weather will be colder next term, we are making the following changes...

Year 1: As Y1 is a year group 'bubble', all classes can be dropped off in the morning between **8.40am-8.50am**. In the afternoon the children can be picked up from **3pm-3.10pm**. (We are still using the Green Close gate)

Year 2: Y2 children can be dropped off between **8.55am and 9am**. As they are in class bubbles the children will go straight into their classrooms. At collection time the children will be **ready from 3.10pm** but we still ask only Polar Bear Class parents arrive at 3.10pm as these children will be released first. (We are still using the Green Close gate)

Any existing special arrangements made with the school or arrangements for siblings still stand so please don't worry.

MFSE AFTER SCHOOL FOOTBALL CLUB



A reminder that on their Club day the Y1 & Y2 children need to bring their kit (and not wear it to school). Reception's football day is the same as their PE day therefore they can keep their PE kit on for football and won't need a separate kit but will need jogging bottoms and a sweatshirt top along with (non-black soled) trainers.

The reason we ask for PE kits to be worn to school on PE days is because the PE session can be at any point in the day and all the children would be changing twice. Football Club being after school means the children only need to change once and also there are not so many of them. We hope this makes sense...
